

## AGREEMENT BETWEEN

PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PALM BEACH COUNTY  
 FOR THE FUNDING OF THE FILM PRODUCTION & DIGITAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE  
 SCHOOL DISTRICT'S FILM & TELEVISION PRODUCTION EDUCATION PROGRAM

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on \_\_\_\_\_, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and The School District of Palm Beach County, a corporate body politic pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOL DISTRICT".

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, SCHOOL DISTRICT owns and operates the eighteen (18) high schools participating in the Film & TV Production Education Program, listed herein and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, SCHOOL DISTRICT established the Career Education Business Leadership Committee (CEBLC), a leadership group of subcommittees, to formalize the community-educator partnership to enhance the quality of film & television instruction offered at the Palm Beach County high schools, and

WHEREAS, SCHOOL DISTRICT desires to acquire film production and digital equipment to further develop the Film & TV Production Education Program, and

WHEREAS, the cost for the purchase, extended warranties and replacement of film production and digital equipment; and distribution of scholarships and equipment awards is estimated at \$198,688, and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of equipment is available from commitments made to the COUNTY's Film & TV Tech Prep Program (FTVTPP) (a) by the Palm Beach International Film Festival (PBIFF) on June 27, 2001 and April 3, 2003, totaling \$98,688 and (b) by the Board of County Commissioners on July 10, 2003, in the amount of \$100,000, totaling \$198,688 toward the purchase of film production and digital equipment for the FTVTPP's participating high schools, and distribution of scholarships/awards to students who participate in the County's International Film Festival, and

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to provide funding for the purchase of said equipment, extended warranties, and distribution of awards, and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to enter into this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

Fund Amount

COUNTY agrees to provide an amount not to exceed \$198,688.00 (One Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Eight Dollars) to SCHOOL DISTRICT for the purchase, extended warranties and replacement of film production and digital equipment, and distribution of awards in the form of video production equipment and student scholarships as specified in Exhibit "A." The maximum budget amount for each of the eighteen schools shall be as specified in Exhibit "A."

Effective Date, Term & Performance Period

The effective date of this Agreement shall be the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2004. The term of this Agreement shall be twelve (12) months from the effective date of this Agreement. This Agreement shall terminate on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2005. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall have twelve (12) months from the effective date of this Agreement to spend the funds on eligible expenses as described in Exhibit "A." Upon written notification to COUNTY at least ninety (90) days prior to the termination date of this Agreement, SCHOOL DISTRICT may request and COUNTY may consider an extension beyond this period for the purpose of completing the tasks listed in Exhibit "A". Said extension shall be granted or denied within the sole discretion of the COUNTY.

Fund Expenses and Reimbursement

COUNTY agrees to reimburse SCHOOL DISTRICT for all eligible expenses actually incurred and paid as described in Exhibit "A" within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the following information:

- A) A written School Board authorization on behalf of each of the eighteen (18) participating high schools to purchase equipment and extended warranties therefor, replace equipment, and distribute awards in the form of video production equipment and student scholarships; and
- B) A Reimbursement Request Form, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B", which is required for each and every reimbursement requested by SCHOOL DISTRICT. Said information shall list each invoice paid by SCHOOL DISTRICT and shall include copies of paid invoices, canceled checks, or other documentation acceptable to the Palm Beach County Office of Financial Management & Budget and the Finance Department of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, and shall make reference thereof to the applicable items listed in Exhibit "A" or its equivalent items. Further, the SCHOOL DISTRICT's Financial Officer shall certify that the total funds spent were paid and approved by the School Board. Invoices shall be submitted to the COUNTY for approval within forty five (45) days following the month in which the expense was incurred. Invoices shall not be honored if received by the Finance Department later than forty-five (45) days after the expiration date of this Agreement, nor will any invoices be honored that predate the effective date of this Agreement.

#### Non Discrimination

SCHOOL DISTRICT warrants that the Palm Beach County School District's Film & TV Production Education Program and the use of film production and digital equipment, as listed in Exhibit "A", shall be made available to all students on a non-discriminatory basis regardless of residency, race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, or sexual orientation.

#### Binding Effect

A) In the event that SCHOOL DISTRICT ceases to exist, or ceases or suspends the tasks described in Exhibit "A" for any reason, any remaining unpaid portion of this Agreement shall be retained by COUNTY and COUNTY shall have no further obligation to honor reimbursement requests submitted by SCHOOL DISTRICT. The determination that SCHOOL DISTRICT has ceased or suspended the tasks shall be made solely by COUNTY, and SCHOOL DISTRICT agrees to be bound by COUNTY's determination.

B) SCHOOL DISTRICT agrees to abide by, and be governed by, all applicable federal, state, local, county, and municipal laws, including but not limited to, COUNTY's ordinances, as said laws and ordinances exist and are amended from time to time. In entering into this Agreement, COUNTY does not waive the requirements of any County or local ordinance or the requirements of obtaining any permits or licenses which are normally required to conduct business or activity conducted by SCHOOL DISTRICT. Failure to comply may result in COUNTY's refusal to honor reimbursement requests.

#### Insurance

Prior to execution of this Agreement by COUNTY, SCHOOL DISTRICT shall provide a statement of self insurance from SCHOOL DISTRICT's Risk Manager. SCHOOL DISTRICT shall, during the term of this Agreement and any extension hereof, maintain in full force and effect self insured or commercial general liability insurance, including contractual liability and completed operations liability, in the amounts specified in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, to specifically cover all exposures associated with Exhibit "A" and the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Where permissible with respect to the above coverages, such policy shall include COUNTY as additional insured and shall contain a clause providing the COUNTY with at least thirty (30) days prior notice in the event of cancellation, non-renewal, or material adverse change in coverage. Compliance with the foregoing requirements shall not relieve SCHOOL DISTRICT of its liability and obligations under this Agreement. SCHOOL DISTRICT agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the COUNTY for any liability arising out of any negligent act or omission of SCHOOL DISTRICT. Nothing in this paragraph shall constitute a waiver of either party's sovereign immunity beyond the limits set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.



#### Construction of Agreement

No party shall be considered the author of this Agreement since the parties hereto have participated in extensive negotiations and drafting and redrafting of this document to arrive at this final Agreement. Thus, the terms of this Agreement shall not be strictly construed against one party as opposed to the other party based on who drafted it. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision hereof shall be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such shall not effect the remaining portions of this Agreement and the same shall remain in full force and effect.

#### Severability

If any term or provision of this Agreement, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, to any extent, be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such terms or provision, to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected, and every other term and provision of this Agreement shall be deemed valid and enforceable to the extent permitted by law.

#### No Forfeiture

The rights of the COUNTY under this Agreement shall be cumulative and failure on the part of the COUNTY to exercise promptly any rights given hereunder shall not operate to forfeit or waive any of the said rights.

#### Waiver

No waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be effective against any party hereto unless it is in writing and signed by the party(s) waiving such provision. A written waiver shall only be effective as to the specific instance for which it is obtained and shall not be deemed a continuing or future waiver.

#### Remedies

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Any legal action necessary to enforce the Agreement will be held in Palm Beach County. No remedy herein conferred upon any party is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy, and each and every such remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy given hereunder or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity, by statute or otherwise. No single or partial exercise by any party of any right, power, or remedy hereunder shall preclude any other or further exercise thereof.

#### Amendments

The COUNTY may, at its discretion, amend this Agreement to conform with changes required by Federal, State, or COUNTY guidelines, directives, and objectives. Such amendments shall be

incorporated by written amendment as a part of this Agreement and shall be subject to approval of the Board of County Commissioners. Except as otherwise provided herein, no amendment to this Agreement shall be binding on either party unless in writing, approved by the Board of County Commissioners and signed by both parties.

#### Independent Contractor Relationship

The SCHOOL DISTRICT is, and shall be, in the performance of all work services and activities under this Agreement, an Independent Contractor, and not an employee, agent, or servant of the COUNTY. All persons engaged in any of the work or services performed pursuant to this Agreement shall at all times, and in all places, be subject to the SCHOOL DISTRICT's sole direction, supervision, and control. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall exercise control over the means and manner in which it and its employees perform the work, and in all respects the SCHOOL DISTRICT's relationship and the relationship of its employees to the COUNTY shall be that of an Independent Contractor and not as employees or agents of the COUNTY. The SCHOOL DISTRICT does not have the power or authority to bind the COUNTY in any promise, agreement or representation.

#### Conflict Of Interest

The SCHOOL DISTRICT represents that it presently has no interest and shall acquire no interest, either direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner with the performance of services required hereunder, as provided for in Chapter 112, Part III, Florida Statutes. The SCHOOL DISTRICT further represents that no person having any such conflict of interest shall be employed for said performance of services. The SCHOOL DISTRICT covenants that no person who presently exercises any functions or responsibilities in connection with the PROGRAM has any personal financial interest, direct or indirect, in the activities provided under this Agreement, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of this Agreement. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall promptly notify the COUNTY's representative, in writing, by certified mail, of all potential conflicts of interest of any prospective business association, interest or other circumstance which may influence or appear to influence the SCHOOL DISTRICT's judgement or quality of services being provided hereunder. Such written notification shall identify the prospective business association, interest or circumstance, the nature of work that the SCHOOL DISTRICT may undertake and request an opinion of the COUNTY as to whether the association, interest or circumstance would, in the opinion of the COUNTY, constitute a conflict of interest if entered into by the SCHOOL DISTRICT. The COUNTY agrees to notify the SCHOOL DISTRICT of its opinion by certified mail within thirty (30) days of receipt of notification by the SCHOOL DISTRICT. If,

in the opinion of the COUNTY, the prospective business association, interest or circumstance would not constitute a conflict of interest by the SCHOOL DISTRICT, the COUNTY shall so state in the notification and the SCHOOL DISTRICT shall, at its option, enter into said association, interest or circumstance and it shall be deemed not in conflict of interest with respect to services provided to the COUNTY by the SCHOOL DISTRICT under the terms of this Contract.

#### Personnel

The SCHOOL DISTRICT represents that it has, or will secure at its own expense, all necessary personnel required to perform the services under this Contract. Such personnel shall not be employees of or have any contractual relationship with the COUNTY. All of the services required herein under shall be performed by the SCHOOL DISTRICT or under its supervision, and all personnel engaged in performing the services shall be fully qualified and, if required, authorized or permitted under state and local law to perform such services. The SCHOOL DISTRICT warrants that all services shall be performed by skilled and competent personnel to the highest professional standards in the field. All of the SCHOOL DISTRICT's personnel (and all Subcontractors) while on County premises will comply with all COUNTY requirements governing conduct, safety and security.

#### Successors and Assigns

The COUNTY and the SCHOOL DISTRICT each binds itself and its partners, successors, executors, administrators and assigns to the other party and to the partners, successors, executors, administrators and assigns of such other party, in respect to all covenants of this Agreement. Except as above, neither the COUNTY nor the SCHOOL DISTRICT shall assign, sublet, convey or transfer its interest in this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other. Nothing herein shall be construed as creating any personal liability on the part of any officer or agent of the COUNTY, nor shall it be construed as giving any rights or benefits hereunder to anyone other than the COUNTY and the SCHOOL DISTRICT.

#### Access and Audits

All reports, plans, surveys, information, documents, maps, and other data procedures developed, prepared, assembled, or completed by the SCHOOL DISTRICT for the purpose of this Agreement shall become the property of the COUNTY without restriction, reservation, or limitation of their use and shall be made available by the SCHOOL DISTRICT at any time upon request by the COUNTY. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall maintain adequate records to justify all charges, expenses, and costs incurred in estimating and performing the work for at least three (3) years after completion or termination of this Contract. The COUNTY shall have access to such books, records, and



documents as required in this section for the purpose of inspection or audit during normal business hours, at the SCHOOL DISTRICT's place of business. The COUNTY reserves the right to require submission of audited financial statements and/or to conduct a "limited scope audit" of the SCHOOL DISTRICT at any time or for any period. Upon thirty (30) days notice to SCHOOL DISTRICT, the COUNTY may require SCHOOL DISTRICT to have a financial system analysis and an internal fiscal control evaluation of the SCHOOL DISTRICT's performance at SCHOOL DISTRICT's expense by an independent auditing firm employed by the COUNTY or by the COUNTY's Internal Auditor at any time the COUNTY deems necessary to determine the capability of the SCHOOL DISTRICT to fiscally manage the grant award.

#### Evaluation And Monitoring

The SCHOOL DISTRICT agrees that the COUNTY will carry out periodic monitoring and evaluation activities as determined necessary by the COUNTY and that the continuation of this Agreement is dependent upon satisfactory evaluation conclusions based on the terms of this Agreement and comparisons of planned versus actual progress relating to project scheduling, budgets, audit reports, and output measures. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall submit information and status reports required by the COUNTY, on forms approved by the COUNTY. The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall allow the COUNTY to monitor the SCHOOL DISTRICT on site. Such visits may be scheduled or unscheduled as determined by the COUNTY.

#### Indemnification

*New Language*  
School Board and County acknowledge the waiver of sovereign immunity for liability in tort contained in Florida Statutes Section 768.28, the State of Florida's partial waiver of sovereign immunity, and acknowledge that such statute permits actions at law to recover damages in tort for money damages up to the limits set forth in such statute for death, personal injury or damage to property caused by the negligent or wrongful acts or omissions of an employee acting within the scope of the employee's office or employment. School Board and County agree to be responsible for all such claims and damages, to the extent and limits provided in Florida Statutes Section 768.28, arising from the actions of their respective employees. The parties acknowledge that the foregoing shall not constitute an agreement by either party to indemnify the other, nor a waiver of sovereign immunity, nor a waiver of any defense the parties may have under such statute, nor as consent to be sued by third parties.

#### Arrears

The SCHOOL DISTRICT shall not pledge the COUNTY'S credit or make it a guarantor of payment or surety for any contract, debt, obligation, judgment, lien, or any form of indebtedness.

Public Entity Crimes

As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the SCHOOL DISTRICT certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder have not been placed on the convicted vendor list maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133(3)(a).

Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be performed in accordance with applicable Federal, Florida, COUNTY laws, ordinances, and codes. These represent minimum regulations which may be supplemented by more restrictive guidelines set forth by the COUNTY. Venue in any action, suit or proceeding in connection with this Agreement shall lie in a Florida State Court of competent jurisdiction located in Palm Beach County.

Entirety of Contractual Agreement

The COUNTY and the SCHOOL DISTRICT agree that this Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the parties, and that there are no promises or understandings other than those stated herein. None of the provisions, terms and conditions contained in this Agreement may be added to, modified, superseded or otherwise altered, except by written instrument executed by the parties hereto in accordance with Article 25- Modifications of Work.



Notice

All notices required by this Agreement shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, hand delivery or other delivery service requiring signed acceptance.
