School requesting that its opening date be deferred until August, 1, 2007. The Charter Department responded on May 11, 2006, and stated that the Charter Agreement would end on or about June 30. 2008 and that the Staff would not recommend a deferral. However, the Charter School on June 16, 2006, made a second request for a deferral, copies of these correspondences are attached hereto

The School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida ("School Board") and the New Vision Child Academy. Inc. ("Charter School"), hereby agree to amend the Agreement entered between the parties on or before

- as Composite Exhibit "A" and in consideration of this second request; Staff would recommend this deferral.
- 2. The request was based upon the fact that a facility would not be available until that date.
- 3. Therefore, the following provisions in the Charter Agreement will need to be extended based on the deferred opening date, specifically:
- Section 12.0 CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION, Paragraph D the enrollment period is a. stated as beginning on April 20, 2006, and ending on February 5, 2007. That ending date shall be extended to February 5, 2007.
 - b. Section 23.0 - FACILITIES, Paragraph D - The Charter School is responsible for the initiation and provision of inspections and an occupational license as required. All
 - facilities, including leased facilities, must be inspected annually by a certified Fire
 - Marshal or inspection specialist and the Palm Beach County Health Department. The Charter School must provide proof of the annual inspections to the Sponsor by May 1 of
 - each year of operation. Other inspections may be required as determined by the Sponsor.
- However, for FY 06-07 that due date shall be extended to May 1, 2007. c.
- Section 23.0 FACILITIES, Paragraph F The Charter School will present proof of the appropriate facility certification (including all certificates that are required by applicable building codes) to the Sponsor no later than May 15 prior to the first year of operation, If the Charter School does not have the appropriate certifications by May 15 prior to the

Section 30 - ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE, e. <u>Paragraph J</u> – The parent member of the Governing Board was required to be named by
- September 15, 2006. That due date shall be extended to September 15, 2007. 4. If the Charter School does not obtain an approved facility on or before June 15, 2007, the parties hereby agree that shall constitute a "good cause" basis for the immediate termination of the Charter Agreement and that the Charter will be terminated effective June 15, 2007. Furthermore, the
- parties hereby agree that the Charter School will not appeal this termination and will fully cooperate with the School Board in the termination process. 5. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Second Amendment and the Charter
- Agreement, the terms of the Second Amendment shall control. 6. The Superintendent is authorized to take administrative action on delayed or deferred openings of Charter Schools.


