

# Generic Educational Specification Summary Sheet

September 2006

## Items for the Yearly Update

1. Time Clock Devices in the main administration area, cafeteria and custodial area.  
Justification: To meet the new standards for employees to report their time. (Bulletin P-12055-COO)
2. Sizes of the AV screens in the classrooms have been revised.  
Justification: Per the request of the Department of Educational Technology. The current AV screens are 8'w x 6'h and the proposed screen size is 80" w x 60" h.
3. The location and size of AV screens; location of the multimedia cabinets, LCD projectors and sound field enhancements in the library media center have been revised.  
Justification: Per the request of the Department of Educational Technology with cooperation from K-12 Instructional Material and Library Media Services and the Building Department. The current AV screen size in the Reading Room of the Library Media Center is 12'w x 10'h and the proposed screen size is 8'w x 6'h. An AV screen (8'w x 6'h), multimedia cabinet and LCD projector have been added to the Group Project area of the Library Media Center for instructional purposes.
4. The Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment (FF&E) matrix has been updated for career spaces.  
Justification: Per the request of the Department of Choice Programs and School Choice, several FF&E matrixes were updated to reflect current technology and teaching techniques.
5. A Pre-Medicine section has been added to the Generic Middle School Educational Specification.  
Justification: Per the request of the Department of Choice Programs and School Choice, the Pre-Medicine section has been added to help develop feeder patterns into high schools that offer medical programs.

6. An Equestrian/Pre-Veterinary section has been added to the Generic High School Educational Specification.

Justification: Per the request of the Department of Choice Programs and School Choice, an Equestrian/Pre-Veterinary was introduced to Wellington High School. This program was added to the menu of the choices to the High School Educational Specification.

7. The Elementary Skills Laboratory for Science has been revised.

Justification: Working with Curriculum Specialists, the Science Skills Laboratory was revised to include clarification of the number and size of sinks and the number of computers.
