ANALYSIS OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT IN THE WEEKDAY WARRIORS PROGRAM FOR FY 2006

An analysis comparing the reading performance of students in the Weekday Warriors Program during FY2006 with a matched comparison group has been completed. The result of the analysis indicated that the mean Lexile score of students in the Program group was not statistically different from that of the comparison group. A detailed description of students in the Program group and its comparison group is reported in Table 1. The result of the analysis is reported in Table 2.
