SUBJECT: FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION ALERTS

The following alerts have been sent by the Florida High School Athletic Association.

- Spring Football Classic Payment/Report - Several member schools have not submitted the financial report and payment of the FHSAA revenue share for the Spring Football Classic. All financial reports and payments received after June 30, 2012 are subject to a significant fine.
- National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Concussion Course - The NFHS Concussion Course is required for the 2012-2013 school year. All head coaches and paid coaches are required to complete this course. There is a state law going into effect July 1, 2012 requiring the coaches to be educated on the nature and risk of concussions and head injuries. This course will satisfy that requirement. www.nfhs.org
- AT17 (Concussion Course Affidavit) - Please remember that the AT17 form is due by August 6, 2012. Each head coach and paid coach is required to view the NFHS Concussion Course before they begin practice this year even if it was viewed last year.
- PA Announcer Football Clinics - The FHSAA and DiCesare-Winter Productions have teamed up to host PA announcer football clinics this fall at three locations: Boca Raton High School on August 25, Dr. Phillips September 8, and Chiles September 15, 2012. - Revised Forms - The revised versions of the EL4, EL7, EL12 and EL14 forms will be available by July 1. For further information, please direct questions to eligibility@fhsaa.org

- Student-Athlete Advisory Committee Nominations – The FHSAA would like to extend the opportunity for student-athletes in member schools to be a part of the FHSAA Student-Advisory Committee. The committee’s purpose is to provide an understanding to the student-athletes of what the Association does while the FHSAA learns about what issues student-athletes face on and off the field. Nomination forms are due by Thursday, August 30, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. Please see the attached document for the nomination form and further information.
- Sportsmanship Stories – The FHSAA would like to promote examples of sportsmanship that happens during practices, games or at special events. We would like to begin posting these stories on the website along with our social media platforms. These can be written by a student, teacher, coach, athletic director, official, fan or parent. We ask that the stories be kept between 250-500 words and the athletic director or principal sign them to ensure that the stories are approved. - C2C Summer Training Dates – The FHSAA has compiled a list of C2C summer training dates for the new 2.0 platform. The attached document has remaining training sessions available. Please note that Braddock High School cannot accept anybody else for training as they have reached capacity. See attachment.
- Compliance Seminar Registration – Registration is open for the 2012 Compliance Seminar to be held for Sections 2 and 4. All member schools in those sections are required to attend and may chose to attend at either location. The seminars will take place at West Broward High School in Pembroke Pines on Thursday, August 9, and at Winter Springs High School on Friday, August 10, 2012. Schools and district athletic personnel not required to attend but are welcome to attend.

FHSAA Student-Athlete Advisory Committee Nomination Form Instructions

1. Download the file onto your computer.
2. Open the file. It should open in either Microsoft Word or WordPerfect.
3. The form is set up as a series of tables. To enter a table, place your cursor in the first cell and click. You may then type your response to the question asked. To move from cell to cell within a table, simply use the "tab" key to move forward and the "shift tab" key to move backward. **Do not type in the cells that are gray-screened.** They contain the questions and headers prepared by the FHSAA Office. Once you have completed all the cells in a table, you must then place your cursor over the first cell of the next table and click to enter that table. Do not attempt to move from one table to the next with the "tab" key. It won't work. Instead, it will create new rows in the table you are in.
4. **Remember to save the file periodically so that you do not lose your work.**
5. Once you have completed the entire form, save it and print out a hard copy. **Make sure you keep a copy of the completed form on file!!!** After securing all required signatures, please fax the completed nomination form to (352) 333-2191 **OR** mail the completed nomination form to:
