STUDENT RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Florida State Legislature requires that all public schools offer character education in all grades (Section 233.061, Florida Statues). The goal of character education is to help students develop socially, ethically, and academically by infusing character development into every aspect of the school culture and curriculum (Education Commission of the United States, April 2001).

For the 9<sup>th</sup> year, the School District is partnering with the *Sum Sentinel* to recognize and support students who demonstrate exemplary character. Each month, classroom teachers, guidance counselors, afterschool staff and/or other school staff select students who best exemplify good character. Each of these students receives a *free* certificate and recognition from their school. From these honorees, the school chooses one student per month to receive the school's *Sun Sentinel Character Counts!* Award which includes a **FREE** *Sun Sentinel* Character Counts! plaque and certificate. Each participating school receives **one** free plaque per month. In May 2013, the *Sun Sentinel* will have a special Sunday Character Counts! article highlighting students showcased throughout the school year.

In order to participate, your school must complete the attached *Sun Sentinel* Character Counts! School Participation Request Form. Detailed instructions are included. Student Intervention Services in the Department of Safe Schools will assist you in the required development and implementation of your Character Education efforts.
