



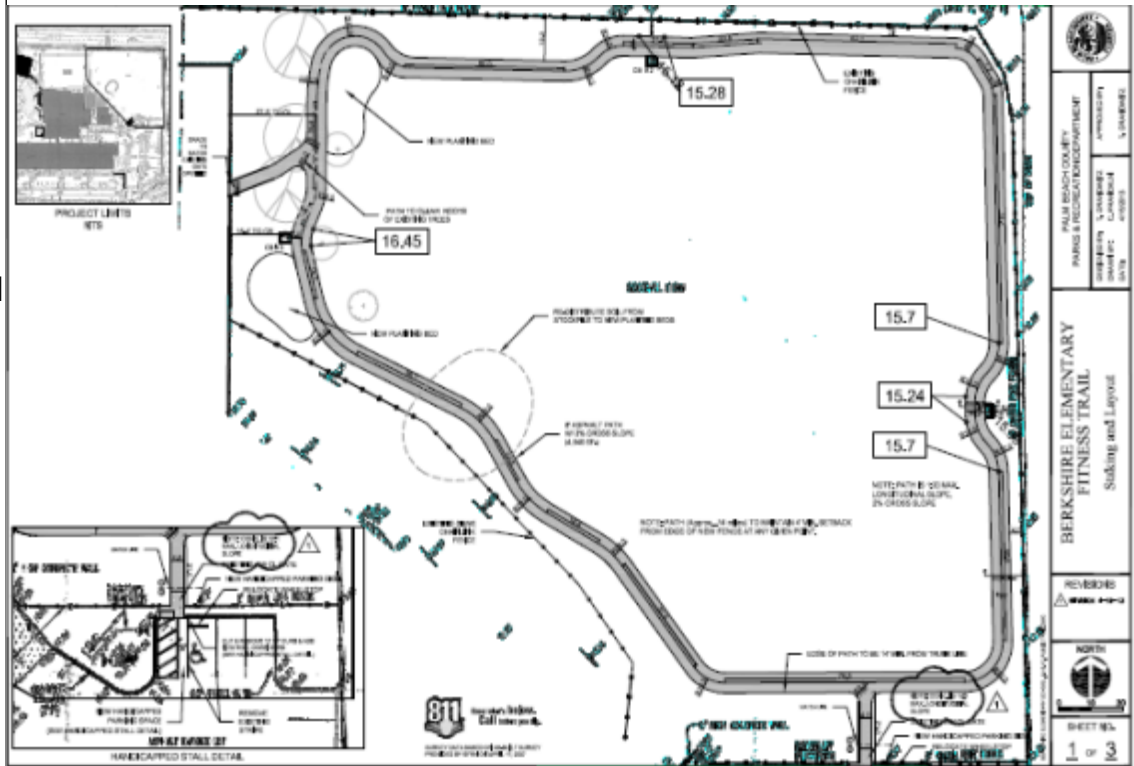

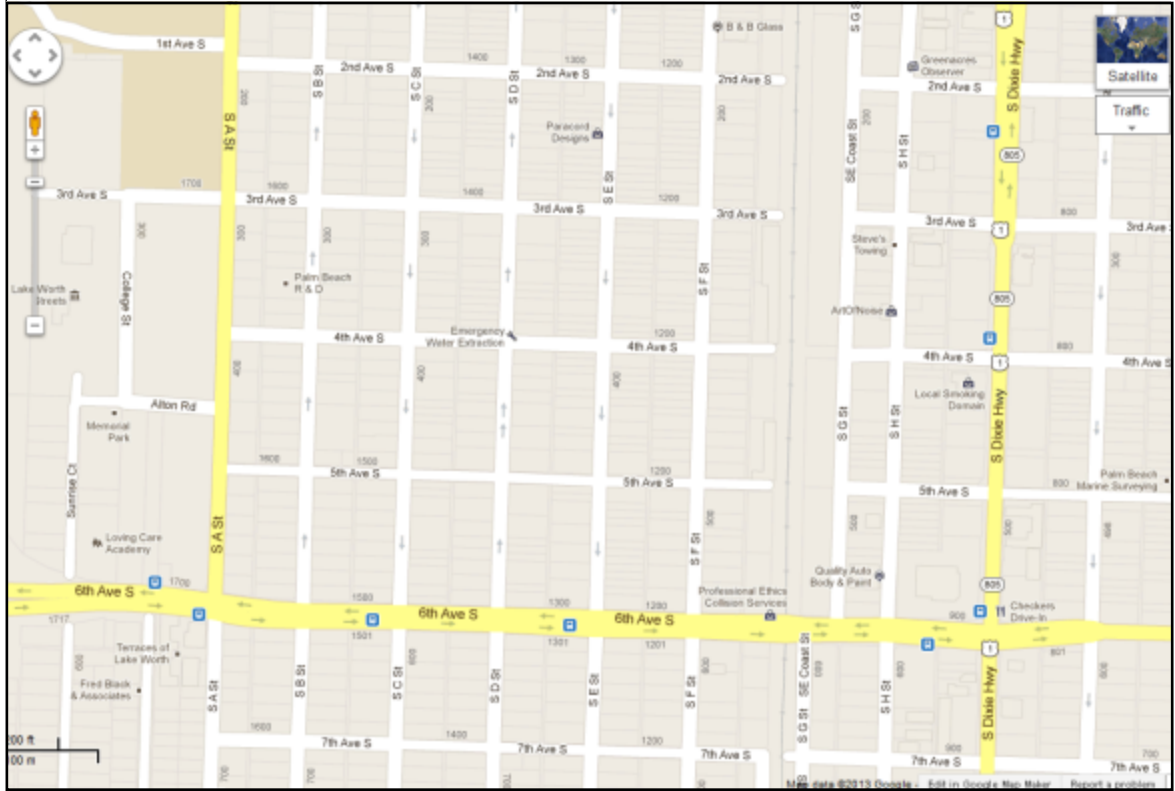

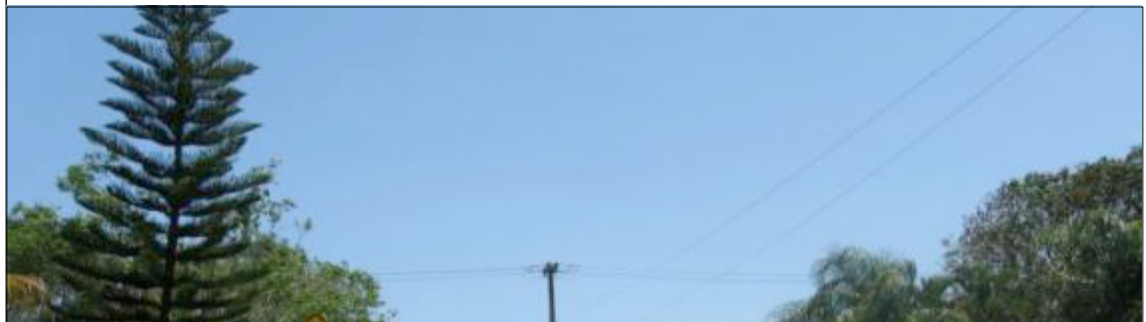
Berkshire Trail update

Bike Trailer – Safe Kids	Another project recently tentatively approved by the TAP funds. The Safe Kids Coalition, in partnership with HKHC and the PE Department at the School District applied for funds to buy 4 new bike trailers, a truck to tow them and a position to coordinate the work. Each bike trailer will be assigned to a quadrant of the county. The remaining trailer will be used for community work. Should also start in 3 years.
