


This Service Level Agreement (SLA) establishes a contract between the School Food Service Department and Santaluces Community High School.

### I. MISSION

The mission of the School Food Service Department is: To provide a variety of appealing and nutritious meals with the purpose of supporting student performance in a safe and effective manner.

At Santaluces Community High School, we believe that every student will achieve at high levels and graduate with the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed in postsecondary education and careers.

Together, the Parties enter into this SLA to mutually promote a sophisticated dining atmosphere that will encourage healthy eating, provide ample seating, and eliminate social stigmas. Accordingly, the <u>School Food Service Department</u> and <u>Santaluces Community High School</u> will operate under this SLA and agree to the following criteria.

#### PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The School Food Service Department and Santaluces Community High School through collaboration will:

- Create a relaxing, inviting, social and safe atmosphere that will promote healthy eating, and support academic success.
- Introduce "trendy" menu segments to promote participation, enhance the overall ambiance of the dining room experience, eliminate social stigmas, and reduce wait time on serving lines.
- Provide adequate time to eat (at least 20 minutes from the time the student is seated).
- Enhance students' learning abilities by contributing to their physical and mental well-being.
- Provide the School Breakfast Program which offers nutritious meals that contain one-fourth of the Recommended Dietary Allowance (RDA) of necessary macro/micro nutrients.
- Provide the National School Lunch Program which offers nutritious meals that contain one-third of the Recommended Dietary Allowance (RDA) of necessary macro/micro nutrients.

### III. RESPONSIBILITIES

Each party will appoint a person to serve as the official contact and coordinate the activities for carrying out this SLA. The initial appointees of each party are:

The parties agree to the following tasks for this SLA:

# The School Food Service Department will:

- Invest allowable capital on behalf of School Food Service for equipment, furniture and fixtures, and the cosmetic remodeling of the dining room
- Design menu concepts based on current trends
- Oversee construction process and completion dates
- Support the School Food Service Manager
- Retrain all School Food Service Employees
- Monitor and record progress
- Develop yearly marketing materials

### Santaluces Community High School will:

- · Support the School Food Service Manager
- Provide office support to assist with the hiring process of cafeteria employees
- Provide a minimum of (3) thirty-five minute lunch periods to accommodate an increase in participation
- Ensure even distribution of students for each lunch period
- Maintain dining area and courtyard routine maintenance
- Ensure leasing groups occupying the cafeteria refrain from any activities that would cause damage to the facility.
- Comply with School Food Service Policy 6.185 regarding the Sale of Competitive Foods and Beverages (Policy is subject to change and procedures must be modified as the changes are made).
- Commit to a 10 year agreement

## IV. TERMS OF UNDERSTANDING

The term of this SLA is for a period of <u>TEN YEARS</u> effective from fiscal year July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2025; this agreement may be extended upon written mutual agreement. It shall be reviewed annually to ensure that it is fulfilling its purpose and to make any necessary revisions.

### Authorization

The signing of this SLA is a formal undertaking. It implies that the signatories will strive to reach, to the best of their ability, the objectives stated in this SLA.
