- $\ge 12 \text{ oz.}$ milk, light juice, juice, and sports drinks
- \approx \leq 150 cal/8 oz. fat-free or low-fat milk
- ≈ ≤ 120 cal/8 oz. 100% juice (NO added sweeteners) AND 10% DV for 3 micronutrients
- $\ge 66 \text{ cal/8 oz.}$ light juices and sports drinks
- ≥ 50% beverages are water and no or low calorie options (≤ 10 cal/8 oz.)

Healthier US School Challenge

- Milk serving is limited to 8 oz.
- Fruit and Vegetable juices. 100% full strength with no sweeteners or non-nutritive sweeteners
 - \circ ≤ 8 ounces
- water (non-flavored, non-sweetened, non-carbonated, non-caffeinated, without non-nutritive sweeteners)
