Summary

- The SSS research project is a major, four-year initiative that involves 4,500 students in 2 school districts, 3 universities (FSU, FAU, UMass) and is funded by the Department of Education's Institute of Education Sciences
- Studied the impact of Student Success Skills on student achievement, classroom behaviors, grades and attendance in grade 5 students
- Results of the teacher and student ratings show that Student Success Skills enhanced the students'
 ability to perform under pressure, increased student motivated engagement in school work, enhanced
 classroom social skills, and decreased student disruption.
