3 4 5 6	1.	Purpose. The Budget Advisory Committee is hereby created for the purposes of making recommendations to the School Board regarding the School District's annual budget and any policies and practices that may be relevant to the budgeting process.

22		g.	Other budget or fiscal matters as determined by the Board,

The Committee shall consist of seven (7) citizens of Palm Beach County, Florida who are volunteers, are not District employees and who exhibit a broad range of interests, including knowledge and interests in budget matters. Each School Board member shall appoint a member to the Committee. The terms of the committee members shall be-as provided in Board Policy 1.09 (Advisory Committees to the Board).

30 31 32		a.	<u>Meetings.</u> The Committee will hold its regular meetings on a quarterly basis, or as otherwise needed, and consistent with the provisions of Board Policy 1.09.
