1	TITLE				
2 3 4	1.	All employees who drive District buses must comply with standards established by the Superintendent.			
5 6	<del>2.</del>	Any employee who knowingly operates a District bus with a suspended or revoked license may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.			
7 8 9	3.	Applicants for the position of school bus driver will not be hired if their driver history record contains either a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or an adjudication within the preceding seven (7) years for one of the following crimes:			
10 11		a. Driving under the influence of alcoholic beverages, chemical substances or controlled substances, or with unlawful blood alcohol levels;			
12 13		b. Leaving the scene of an accident where there was an injury and/or property damage exceeding \$500.00;			
14		c. Reckless driving resulting in an accident;			
15		d. Fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer.

Employees who operate a District bus during the performance of their regular duties and who plead noto contendere or guilty, or who are found guilty committing any of the crimes listed in Section 4 of this policy, will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
