



### **POLICY 2.291**

**4-E** I recommend that the Board adopt the proposed revised Policy 2.291, entitled "Replacement of Vehicles."

#### **Adoption**

#### **CONSENT ITEM**

- The Board approved development of this revised Policy at the development reading on July 9, 2008, but requested the following change:
  - Line 12 – add language "or operate"
- This policy is being revised to reflect the increased durability and reliability of vehicles, and extended and enhanced vehicle warranty coverage. The revision would extend the life-cycle of Service Vehicles, maximize depreciation and reduce budget cost for replacement units.
- This revision does provide for an earlier replacement of a vehicle based on the standards in the policy including safety.
- This revision also updates statutory references.

**POLICY 2.291**

**REPLACEMENT OF VEHICLES**

1. Board-owned motor vehicles should be considered for replacement when the following criteria are reached:
  - a. ~~Passenger cars, 6 years or 60,000 miles~~ Passenger cars, 7 years or 120,000 miles
  - b. ~~Light duty trucks and vans, 7 years or 70,000 miles~~ Light duty trucks and vans, 10 years or 180,000 miles
  - c. ~~Heavy duty trucks, 10 years or 100,000 miles~~ Heavy duty trucks, 10 years or 240,000 miles
  - d. School buses, 10 years or ~~100,000~~ 200,000 miles ,or
  - e. Uneconomical to repair or operate
2. This policy shall not preclude an earlier or later replacement if ~~deemed economically desirable by the director of transportation,~~ as the Superintendent's designee, determines that the District's action is economically desirable, efficient, safe, and in compliance with the law.
