1 2	STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR FORMER SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES

4 5 6 7	1. As stated in Fla. Stat. § 112.313(14) ("Lobbying by former local officers prohibition"), a former School Board member "may not personally representation another person or entity for compensation before the governing body of which the person was an officer for a period of 2 years after vacating that office."
8 9 10 11 12	2. Pursuant to Fla. Stat. § 112.313(13), a "school district employee may not personally represent another person or entity for compensation before the government body or agency of which the individual was an officer or employee for a period of 2 years following vacation of office or termination of employment except for the purposes of collective bargaining."
13 14 15 16 17 18	3. Consistent with Fla. Stat. § 112.312(20), the phrase "personally represent another person or entity for compensation" shall refer to "actual physical attendance or behalf of a client in an agency proceeding, the writing of letters or filing or documents on behalf of a client, and personal communications made with the officers or employees of any agency on behalf of a client" for compensation by that client.
19 20	4. This Policy shall be construed consistent with relevant Opinions of the Florida Commission on Ethics, including CEO 01-5.
