1	EMPLOYMENT OF TEACHER AIDES AND INSTRUCTIONAL AIDES

3	A teacher aide or instructional aide is any person assigned by the School Board to	
4	render services under the supervision of a certified employee. A teacher aide shall not	
5	be assigned to duties requiring knowledge of instructional practices and policies.	
6	The Superintendent shall establish guidelines for assuring that each teacher aide or	
7	instructional aide is provided with the necessary knowledge to perform duties in a	
8	proper and reasonable manner.
