POLICY 3.90

1	MINIMUM DAYS FOR A YEAR OF CREDIT ON SALARY SCHEDULE
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3	1. A total of more than half (1/2) of the number of days required for the normal
4	appointive period of service for the position held shall be the minimum requirement
5	for a year's credit. Compensable leave shall be considered a part of the required
6	days of service for credit. Monetary gains for an employee under the provisions of
7	this policy shall be subject to approval by the Board.
