Development

CONSENT ITEM

- The Department of Choice Programs and School Choice has prepared a procedures manual to provide guidelines for matters such as the History and Purpose of choice schools and programs in Palm Beach County, Kinds of Choice Programs, Attendance Boundary Options, Academic or Related Eligibility Criteria, Recruitment, Application Process, Selection Process, Appeals Process, Transportation, Student Continuation and Exit Procedures, Creating, Replicating, or Moving a Choice School or Program, Determining Continuation of Existing Choice Schools or Programs, Diversity and District-Wide Maintenance of School Populations.
- This new Policy would incorporate this Procedures Manual by reference.
- A recommendation for adoption of an emergency rule (5.016-ER) is also being made simultaneously on September 13 because the Policy should be adopted as close as possible to the beginning of the school year and before the due date for a major grant application that may call for the existence of such Policy. This regular development process is likely to be completed by October or November, before the emergency rule would expire on December 12, 2006.
