CONSENT ITEM

- This Policy, last revised in 1983, is recommended for repeal, as it is no longer needed in view of a more comprehensive Policy (8.01) on Promotion, Placement and Graduation, which includes admission to first grade information in the Elementary Student Progression Plan.
- The Policy should be repealed under Fla. Stat. § 120.74 which requires agencies to "delete obsolete or unnecessary rules."
