MINIMUM COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGE

A student who attains the age of sixteen (16) during the school year is not subject to
compulsory attendance beyond the date upon which he/she attains that age if the
student and parent or legal guardian files a signed formal declaration of intent to
terminate school enrollment with the District at the exit interview.
