2 3	1.	A married student may remain in and complete the regular public school program.
4 5 6 7	2.	If after a reasonable period of time however, it is the judgment of the principal that the student's behavior or presence creates a problem in the school, the principal may recommend to the guidance services department that the student be transferred to another school.
8 9	3.	The option to transfer to the adult education program or other appropriate alternative education program is to be available to any married student.
