CONSENT ITEM

- The Policy should be repealed under Fla. Stat. § 120.74, which requires agencies to "delete obsolete or unnecessary rules."

~~TUTORING (HOME) IN LIEU OF REGULAR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE~~

~~The Superintendent shall develop procedures to permit home tutoring in lieu of regular school attendance. The procedures shall provide for compliance with existing state laws and rules and regulations of the State Board of Education and must include, but are not limited to:~~

~~1. The filing of a Declaration of Intent to use tutors in lieu of school attendance.~~

~~2. Documentation of eligibility and qualifications of the home tutors.~~

~~3. Maintenance of appropriate records and submission to the School Board of reports as requested regarding student attendance, instructional time, achievement of instructional objectives, health and personal data as may be required if the student should enter the public school system.~~
