- This revision provides the circumstances under which students shall be excused from attendance for religious instruction, observation of a religious holiday or because the tenets of the student's religion forbid secular activity at such time.
- Procedures to address absence for religious reasons are provided. Annual notification of this policy and related procedure and guidelines is also included.
- This revision also updates statutory references.

Students shall be afforded an opportunity to make up missed work any examination, study or work assignment which has been missed for religious purposes, and without adverse effects if absent from school because of their religious holidays.		
15		a.	The religious instruction shall be the responsibility of the religious institution.	
16 17 18		b.	Transportation of the student to and from the religious institution where the religious instruction or holiday observance is held shall be the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

The student's parent or legal guardian shall execute an appropriate form which indemnifies and holds harmless the School Board from all liability for conduct which occurs on property over which the School Board has no control or supervision as a condition precedent to approval of the requested time for religious instruction.
