6 1. ~~These funds may be used for any school food service purpose provided that the~~
7 ~~school food service department adheres to all laws and state board regulations and~~

9 2. ~~Any funds derived from the sale of empty containers shall be deposited in the~~
10 ~~school centralized lunch fund and earmarked for the respective schools.~~

11 3. ~~Any discounts or rebates on school food service purchases shall be deducted from~~
