1	Special school food service funds shall be considered those funds derived from the sale of empty containers such as tin cans, bottles, jugs, boxes, various paper and fiber sacks.

11 12	<del>3.</del>	Any discounts or rebates on school food service purchases shall be deducted from the vendor's statement.
