Adoption

CONSENT ITEM

- The Board approved development of this revised Policy at the development reading on June 3, 2009.
- This revision clarifies the current practice of use of football facilities by another school. The revision also addresses the method of payment, and related internal accounts, for persons not employed by the School District; and entering of payroll, and related accounts, in People Soft for District employees.
- This revision also updates statutory references.

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1 SHARING OF FOOTBALL FACILITIES BY PALM BEACH COUNTY PUBLIC

- 4 1. Occasions arise when a school needs to use the football facilities of another school
5 such as when the school's football stadium is under construction or undergoing
6 major renovation.
- 7 2. Where the football facilities of a senior high or full secondary school are used by
8 another school which assumes the role of host school for a game, the following
9 conditions will apply:
- 10 a. The host school for the game shall also assume the costs associated with its
11 home games and provide payment as needed and in the manner as stated
12 below for the services of custodial and other personnel (game officials, ticket
13 sellers, security details, etc.) supplied by the school where the facilities are
14 located.
- 15 b. The host school will pay directly from its internal funds any of these persons
16 who are not employed by the School District. As to District employees
17 associated with the home game, the host school will enter them in payroll
18 through People Soft using the host school's department number, and the
19 amounts will then be invoiced to the host school's internal accounts.
