POLICY 6.27

~~FOOD PREPARED OUTSIDE THE REGULAR SCHOOL FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM~~

~~1. The following criteria for the preparation of foods outside the regular school food service program shall be followed:~~

~~a. No such foods shall leave the premises of the school center at which they are prepared.~~

~~b. No extra foods shall be prepared for activities other than official school functions.~~

~~c. When extra foods are prepared or served for a special event, the cafeteria manager or a food service employee must be on duty, and agree to perform any overtime activity.~~

~~d. Both the food and labor costs for such events must be fully reimbursed to the School Food Service Program by the sponsoring group.~~


