## **CONSENT ITEM**

- The Board approved development of this revised Policy at the development reading on July 9, 2008.
- The proposed revision/amendment to subparagraph 1c of Policy 6.27 permits School Food Service to provide a food service worker from another available school should a food service worker of the requesting school not be available for a scheduled event.
- The added language to subparagraph 1d is provided for clarity.
- This revision also updates statutory references.

- 1. The following criteria for the preparation of foods outside the regular school food service program shall be followed:
- 5 a. No such foods shall leave the premises of the school center at which they are prepared.
- 7 b. No extra foods shall be prepared for activities other than official school functions.
- 9 c. When extra foods are prepared or served for a special event, the cafeteria manager or a food service worker from that school employee must be on duty, and agree to perform any overtime activity.
- d. Both the food and labor costs for such events must be fully reimbursed to the School Food Service Program by the sponsoring group.
