CONSENT ITEM

 This revision removes outdated references and includes new guidelines for the publication of data. This proposed revision incorporates by reference the Public School Concurrency Interlocal Agreement. It also set forth standards that are consistent with the Interlocal Agreement and school district and local government practices and Florida Statutes.

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POLICY 7.131

COORDINATED PLANNING

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2 3 1. Cooperation - The Superintendent/designee shall exchange data with local 4 governments to coordinate planning in accordance with the Public School 5 Concurrency Palm Beach County Interlocal Agreement with Municipalities of Palm Beach County and the School District of Palm Beach County to Establish Public 6 7 School Concurrency, as amended ("Interlocal"). for the term of the Interlocal. A copy of the Interlocal can be found on the District's Planning Department website at 8 9 www.pbcschoolplanning.info.

Student Enrollment Projections - Using the Cohort Survivor method as its foundation, the District shall endeavor to improve enrollment projection methodologies pursuant to the adopted Interlocal. The following shall serve as inputs to the projections:

- 14a.By November 1st of each year, the Superintendent/designee will utilize the15Florida Department of Education Student Enrollment Projections together with16the local government and Florida Bureau of Economic and Business Research17("BEBR") population projections to develop student enrollment projections.
- 18b.The District shall use annual estimates of new residential housing units as19provided by the Palm Beach County Planning, Zoning and Building20Department as a basis for public school student enrollment population21projections.
- c. The District shall evaluate disaggregated projections of new residential
 housing units prepared by the Palm Beach County Planning, Zoning, and
 Building Department, considering the population projections contained in each
 local government's comprehensive plan and the Florida Department of
 Education Capital Outlay Full Time Equivalent ("COFTE") student enrollment
 projections.
- d. The District shall endeavor to improve enrollment projection methodologies
 pursuant to the adopted Interlocal.
- 30 **3. Student Enrollment Multipliers - a**The District shall initially apply student 31 enrollment generation multipliers pursuant to the Interlocal.
