2 3 4 5	1.	<u>Purpose To provide district schools with an opportunity to initiate leadership and character development programs with business, governmental and community partnerships.</u>
6 7 8 9 10 11	2.	Policy It is the policy of the School Board to support innovative programs within its schools and to enhance student achievement through leadership and character development. Schools, with the approval of the Superintendent/designee, may include as an extracurricular activity and/or within their curriculum a course promoting leadership and character development through programs such as the Civil Air Patrol.
12 13 14 15 16 17	3.	Delegation of Authority The School Board has delegated authority to the Superintendent or his/her designee to enter into and sign agreements with organizations to provide leadership and character development courses and extracurricular activities. Prior to their approval, the agreements must be reviewed for legal sufficiency by the Chief Counsel's office/designee, and the activity and course must be compliant with federal and state law as well as School Board policies.
19 20 21 22	4.	Related Fees Any fees, including membership fees to the organization, shall relate solely to the extracurricular activity and shall not be a requirement for taking the course. This does not preclude requesting voluntary payments from students as per School Board Policy 2.21.
23 24 25	5.	Report to School Board Within 30 days of the effective date of any agreement approved under this Policy, the Superintendent shall provide notice to the School Board of the agreement.
