Repeal-Adoption CONSENT ITEM

- The Board approved development of this repeal on February 27, 2008.
- This Policy, last revised in 1983, is recommended for repeal because it is no longer needed under current practices.
- The Policy related to the three Vo-Tech Centers that existed in the District prior to 1999. It is not relevant to career academies or tech centers.
- The Policy should be repealed under Fla. Stat. § 120.74, which requires agencies to "delete obsolete or unnecessary rules."
