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POLICY 3.01

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POLICY FOR BARGAINING UNIT EMPLOYEES

Board policies apply to all District employees and personnel, including those 6 personnel subject to negotiated bargaining agreements. When a provision of a 7 Board Policy conflicts with a provision of a ratified bargaining agreement, the 8 specific provision of the Nnegotiated contracts takes precedence as Board policy 9 for employees in that particular certified bargaining units.
