- This revision updates the Policy to reflect the current DOE State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF).
- The proposed revision was reviewed and approved by CORC and the Chief of Facilities.

POLICY 7.10 1 2 **CONSTRUCTION BID PROCEDURES** 3 4 1. When Bids Are Required. As required by SREF § 4.2(2) and Fla. Stat. § 255.20. 5 the bidding process shall be used to award all construction, remodeling, or 6 renovation/addition projects for any educational plant or ancillary facility amounting to two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) or more and electrical projects of fifty 7 8 thousand (\$50,000) or more unless other contract processes authorized by law are 9 used. 10 Required Notice. When a contract is to be let for new construction, remodeling or 11 the renovation of or addition to any educational plant or ancillary facility amounting 12 to fifty thousand dollars (\$50.000) or more, and Regardless of whether or not the 13 construction documents were required to be submitted to the Office of Educational 14 Facilities Construction, Florida Department of Education, a legal notice shall be 15 published for projects estimated to cost two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) or more and electrical projects estimated to cost fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or 16 17 more, giving briefly the essential information relating to the construction project. Further, construction projects costing less than \$200,000 which will be completed 18 with contracted services shall be advertised a minimum of one week. and 19 20 3. Content of Notice. The notices mentioned in section (2) should shall include at 21 least the following, pursuant to SREF § 4.2(2)(a): 22 a. Project name and name of the School Board. 23 b. Location of the project. 24 A statement giving the location where bids are to be filed. C. d. Date, time and place of opening bids. 25 26 Brief statement of work contemplated and identification of location of work by e. 27 project name. Where and when plans and specifications will be available, including whether 28 f. 29 a deposit or charge is required. 30 Any other information that may be helpful to prospective bidders, such as the g. 31 requirements for bid bonds and deposits for plans and specifications, notice of 32 any pre-bid conference, bid security, insurance, and whether the Board 33 intends to waive minor technicalities.

Timing of Notice. The legal notice shall be published once each week for three

(3) consecutive weeks as required by SREF § 4.2(2)(b), on the same day of the

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week. All official advertisements shall <u>be published in a newspaper of general</u> circulation in this county to comply with the provisions of Chapter 50, Florida Statutes.

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The last such notice shall appear at least seven (7) days prior to the date set for the opening of bids. Any correction or change in advertisement shall be made at least seven (7) days prior to the final date set for opening of bids; however, the original date set for opening of bids may be changed and extended at any time within the final seven (7) day period provided the notice to bidders is published again for one (1) time at least seven (7) days prior to the new bid date as set forth above, and each known prospective bidder is notified in writing of the change.

- 50 5. Availability. Plans and specifications shall be available to prospective bidders within a reasonable time after their initial request. In addition to publication of the notice, the Board shall require that the invitation to bid be mailed or delivered to not less than three (3) prospective bidders and/or shall be distributed to area plan review rooms, pursuant to SREF § 4.2(2)(c).
- 6. Bid Content. Contractors shall include information, as required by law, with their
 bid, such as, but not limited to:
- 57 <u>a. assurance of conformance with Public Entity Crime Law, Fla. Stat. §</u>
 58 <u>287.133(2)(a) and</u>
- b. a reference to the trench safety standard, where relevant, and written
 assurance that the contractor will comply with the Trench Safety Act, Fla. Stat.
 §§ 553.60 through 553.64; and
- 62 c. subcontractors listed in the bid shall not be replaced without cause, once the list has been opened and made public, in accordance with Fla. Stat. § 255.0515.
- 7. Bid Receipt, Opening, and Tabulation.-- Bids shall be received, publicly opened and tabulated at a designated time and place by an employee of the Board or other designated individual, in accordance with SREF § 4.2(2)(e).
- 8. <u>Selection and Award.--</u> The board shall consider all bids received and, within the time limit listed in the specification, either <u>reject all bids or identify the apparent lowest responsible bidder, considering base bid and accepted alternates as listed in the bidding documents, and award the contract to the lowest responsible that</u>

- bidder for the actual amount bid <u>and the contract shall include a time limit in which</u>
 the construction is to be completed, as required by SREF § 4.2(2)(h) considering
 base bid and accepted alternates as listed in the bidding documents, or reject all bids.
- 9. Potential Waiver of Minor Technicalities.-- No bid shall be considered if the bidder fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the bid form or the procedure for submitting bids as authorized in the official advertisement and other documents pertaining to the bidding as authorized by the Board. The Board reserves the right to waive minor irregularities technicalities if so stated in the bid advertisement.
- 10. Prerequisite to Letting Bids.-- The Board shall have received notice from the Office of Educational Facilities Construction, Department of Education, when required, that Phase III documents are approved prior to awarding of bids.
- 11. Alternates.-- As stated in SREF § 4.2(2)(f), alternates listed in the bidding documents may be accepted at any time after the contract award by change order provided the contractor remains the low bidder on the combination of the base bid and the alternatives selected.
