CONSENT ITEM

- The Board approved this revision as a first reading for development on July 28, 2003. The adoption notice was published on August 11, 2003.
- The minor revisions proposed in this Policy and three others in Chapter 7 are needed to implement amendments to the Interlocal Agreement for Concurrency, on which at least 51% of the municipalities have recently signed off.
- Statutory citations are updated to reflect the new K-20 Education Code, and references to the Five-Year Capital Facilities Plan are updated to conform to Fla. Stat. § 1013.35 and SREF as the Five-Year "District Facilities Work Program."
- Any Board member with technical questions about this revision is invited to confer with the contact persons listed above.

POLICY 7.131

COORDINATED PLANNING

- 1. Introduction <u>Cooperation.—</u> The Superintendent/designee shall exchange data with local governments to coordinate planning in accordance with the Public School Concurrency Interlocal Agreement ("Interlocal") for the term of the Interlocal.
- 5 2. Student Enrollment Projections.— Using the Cohort Survivor method as its foundation, the District shall endeavor to improve enrollment projection methodologies pursuant to the adopted Interlocal. The following shall serve as inputs to the projections:
- a. By February 25, 2002, and annually thereafter November 1st of each year, the Superintendent/designee will utilize the Florida Department of Education Student Enrollment Projections together with the local government and Florida Bureau of Economic and Business Research ("BEBR") population projections to develop student enrollment projections.
- b. The District shall use annual estimates of new residential housing units as provided by the Palm Beach County Planning, Zoning and Building Department as a basis for public school student enrollment population projections.
- c. The District shall evaluate disaggregated projections of new residential housing units prepared by the Palm Beach County Planning, Zoning, and Building Department, considering the population projections contained in each local government's comprehensive plan and the Florida Department of Education Capital Outlay Full Time Equivalent ("COFTE") student enrollment projections.
- d. The District shall endeavor to improve enrollment projection methodologies pursuant to the adopted Interlocal.

26 3. Student Enrollment Multipliers

- 27 a. The District shall initially apply student enrollment generation multipliers pursuant to the Interlocal.
- b. By January 2002, the Superintendent/designee will update student enrollment generation multipliers for different housing unit types for new residential construction utilizing data from the Palm Beach County Property Appraisers Office and fall 2001 student data.

33 4. Publication of Data:

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a. The District shall annually publish the:

- i. Annual update of the district's Five-Year <u>District</u> Capital Facilities <u>Work</u>

 Plan <u>Program</u> ("<u>Program</u> Plan") (also known as the Five-Year Capital <u>Facilities Plan</u>).
- 38 ii. First student count of the second semester of each school year First FTE student enrollment count of all schools of each type in each CSA and each individual school.
- b. On or before April 1 November 1 of each year, the Superintendent/designee shall publish updated data concerning school Florida Inventory of School Houses Housing ("FISH") capacity. This shall include the:
 - i. Enrollment of each individual school based on the first <u>FTE</u> student count of the second semester of each school year; and
 - ii. Actual capacity of each school based on the FISH study; or
- iii. Number of students that may be housed at a facility given the current educational program; and
- iv. Enrollment and capacity for all schools of each type in each Concurrency Service Area ("CSA").
- 51 5. **Update of Data.—** The District shall specifically update the data regarding the utilization of the schools upon any of the following occurrences when:
- a. New capacity becomes operational; or
- b. A School Capacity Study ("SCS") is approved; or
- 55 c. Residential concurrency determinations are issued.
- 6. **Coordinated Information.** On or before October 1 of each year the Superintendent/designee shall provide to each local government the adopted Program Plan showing existing and planned public school facilities and construction.

7. Proposed School Sites

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- a. Pursuant to Article VIII, Section G of the Interlocal, on or before October 15 of each year, the Superintendent/designee shall coordinate planning and site location of educational facilities with each local government.
- b. The District will provide an updated comprehensive map series which shows
 school site(s) which are proposed for construction or site acquisition based
 upon the adopted <u>Program Plan</u>.
- 8. Infrastructure Requirements.— Upon identifying specific sites for schools, the
