7	1.	The School Board of Palm Beach County values the educational development of each		
8		student in the district. District instructional personnel will consider the individual student's		
9		academic needs when placing students in subjects, grade levels, or specialty programs.

13	<u>2.</u>	Promotion between grade levels shall be based upon evaluation of each student's		
14		performance and achievement. To assist and guide school officials in their decisions on		
15		placement, promotion, retention, and special programs, the Superintendent has developed a Student Progression Plan 2003-2004, which is incorporated by reference into this Board		
16 17		policy. Copies of the Plan shall be maintained in the District office and at each school.		
18		The plan must include student performance standards and promotional and graduation		
19		requirements for grades K-12; adult general education; exceptional student education; and		
20		dual enrollment. Before being presented to the Board for annual approval, the revised and		
21		updated Student Progression Plan will be reviewed for compliance with Florida law and		
22		State Board of Education rules.

24	<u>3.</u>	As required by Fla. Stat. §1008.25(7)(b)5, the District shall "annually publish in the local		
25		newspaper[a]ny revisions to [this] policy on student retention and promotion from the		
26 07		prior year," referring to changes in the Student Progression Plan incorporated into this		
27 28		<u>policy.</u>		
29	1	The Superintendent is authorized to establish a comprehensive program for Pupil		
30		Progression which shall be based upon evaluation of each pupil's performance.		
31				
32	2	The Program of Pupil Progression, which is in compliance with State law and Department		
33		of Education regulations, shall be based upon goals and objectives established by the		
34		Board.		
35				
36	3	The Program of Pupil Progression shall reflect an effort to identify students who have		
37		attained a cumulative grade point average of 1.5 or below. The program shall further		
38		include provisions for assisting such students to achieve the cumulative grade point		
39 40		average required for graduation.		
40 41	4	The Superintendent shall promulgate a directive which includes the complete Pupil
