The School District of Palm Beach County has been putting its share of the **one-cent sales tax** to use. A <u>series of projects</u> are being funded by proceeds from the one-cent sales tax, which is expected to generate approximately \$2.7 billion over the next 10 years.

\$5 million to purchase computer equipment.

Independent Sales Surtax Oversight Committee



The purpose of the committee is to oversee the proceeds of the sale tax revenue.

\$5,946,410 of sales tax proceeds to date have been invested into HVAC units and/or repair, and there is another \$6.4M in purchase orders in process.

In total, **44 schools** have received new chiller units, and an additional 64 schools have units on order.
