

**Palm Beach County School District – Nova Southeastern University (NSU)
Teacher Training Agreement – English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
Pilot Undergraduate Online Course Agreement**

NSU agrees to provide the Category One Undergraduate Online program to 25 participants, in the course with textbooks for a total amount of \$22,875.00 under a contract with the Palm Beach County School District (PBCSD).

This proposal intends to develop a collaborative agreement between the Palm Beach County School District and the Fischler School of Education and Human Services at Nova Southeastern University. The Palm Beach School District – NSU Teacher Training Agreement is designed to provide Palm Beach County teachers the appropriate undergraduate online coursework as mandated by the Multicultural Education Training and Advocacy (META) Consent Degree of August 14, 1990.

State of Florida Endorsement Requirements:

Certification in another subject appropriate to the teaching assignment (Elementary Education, English ESE, or Foreign Language).

- Curriculum Development in TSOL
- Testing and Evaluation in BLE/TSOL

One of the courses listed below will be delivered during an eight-week period in an online format via WebCT. Since this will be an undergraduate course, the credit earned with this course **cannot** be used toward the Master of Science in Education with a specialization in TESOL.
