

**AMENDMENT #011 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF
PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR FUNDING OF
AFTER SCHOOL RECREATION PROGRAMS**

THIS AMENDMENT #011 TO AGREEMENT, is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2005, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", and the School Board of Palm Beach County, a corporate body politic pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "School Board."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on November 15, 1994, the County approved an Agreement (R-94-1661D) with the School Board to assist in the funding of the After School Program for Middle School Students, hereinafter referred to as the "After School Program"; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 1995, the County approved Amendment #001 (R-95-1197D) to Agreement (R-94-1661D) which allocated \$137,000 to the School Board for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in eighteen (18) middle schools; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1996, the County approved Amendment #002 (R-96-1490D) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$128,000 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in sixteen (16) middle schools, and direct program planning and coordination support to eight (8) middle schools; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 1997, the County approved Amendment #003 (R-97-1048D) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$157,344 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's twenty four (24) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 1998, the County approved Amendment #004 (R-98-1751D) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$193,700 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's twenty six (26) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1999, the County approved Amendment #005 (R-99-2232) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$267,700 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's twenty six (26) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2000, the County approved Amendment #006 (R-2000-1686) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$278,054 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program, increased the number of schools to twenty seven (27) middle schools participating in the After School Program and broadly outlined how the funding should be expended and;

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2001, the County approved Amendment #007 (R-2001-1951) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$278,054 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's twenty nine (29) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2003, the County approved Amendment #009 (R-2003-1816) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$308,642 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's thirty (30) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2004, the County approved Amendment #010 (R-2004-2000) which provided supplemental funding in the amount of \$330,000 for the expansion and/or enhancement of the recreation component of the After School Program in the School Board's thirty three (33) middle schools participating in the After School Program; and provided for the County to conduct annual FDLE background checks for individuals or companies hired by the School Board to provide recreation services to the After School Program; and

WHEREAS, the County and the School Board desire to further amend Agreement (R-94-1661D) as amended by R-95-1197D, R-96-1490D, R-97-1048D, R-98-1751D and R-99-2232D, R-2000-1686D, R-2001-1951D, R-2002-1751D, R-2003-1816D, R-2004-2000D, hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Agreement", to provide for the continuous funding and support of the After School Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreements expressed herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Agreement is amended by deleting the date "September 30, 2005" and inserting in its place the date "September 30, 2006."
2. Section 2, Number 1, of the Agreement is amended by deleting "\$330,000" and inserting in its place the number "\$340,000."
3. Section 2, Number 1, of the Agreement is further amended by deleting "thirty three (33) middle schools" and inserting in its place "thirty four (34) middle schools."
4. Section 2, Number 3, of the Agreement is amended by deleting, "A Recreation Consultant is an individual or company hired by the School Board to provide a recreation service to the After School Program. The School Board shall perform the initial screening, fingerprinting and Nationwide background check of each prospective Recreation Consultant, at the prospective Recreation Consultant's expense. For each Recreation Consultant that is approved by the School Board, the County shall fund and have performed an annual FDLE background check in every year subsequent to School Board approval in which the Recreation Consultant works in the After School Program. In the event that a Recreation Consultant does not participate in the After School Program for a period of ninety (90) consecutive days during a school year (exclusive of summer break), the Recreation Consultant shall be required to reapply to the School Board and again undergo the initial screening, fingerprinting and Nationwide background check by School Board", and inserting in its place "A Recreation Consultant is an individual or company hired by the School Board to provide a recreation service to the After School Program. The School Board shall perform level 2 FDLE screening and FBI screening - fingerprinting of each prospective Recreation Consultant, at the prospective Recreation Consultant's expense. The School Board shall be the sole determiner of clearance. Once cleared, each prospective Recreation Consultant will receive a School District picture badge, identifying that they have been cleared through the screening process with an expiration date by which they have to get this screening renewed. The renewed screening will also be at the expense of the Recreation Consultant. All Recreation Consultants must have a valid School District badge to enter a school "
