

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN PREVENTION PARTNERSHIPS FOR CHILDREN, INC.
AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF PALM BEACH COUNTY**

**Contract #: P-127
Specialist in Evaluation & Test Development Position**

December 14, 2005

The Prevention Partnerships for Children, Inc. ("PPC") has agreed to fund up to \$167,029 for a full-time Specialist in Evaluation & Test Development Position, as outlined on the attached Exhibit "A", to the School District of Palm Beach County ("School District") for January 20, 2005, through September 30, 2006 ("effective period").

PPC agrees to transfer funds to the School District in accordance with the following schedule and terms:

1. PPC will transfer up to \$167,029 to the School District for the period January 20, 2005, through September 30, 2006, in fixed monthly installment of \$7,953.76 for the effective period and as outlined on the attached Exhibit "A".
2. School District agrees to forward invoices to PPC by the 10th of each month following the month in which the services were provided. The invoice will include documentation reflecting all encumbrances and expenditures made by the School District under this Memorandum of Agreement, in whatever form reasonably required by PPC. PPC will not reimburse School District for any expenditure under this Memorandum of Agreement made after September 30, 2006.
3. The School District agrees to refund any of PPC's money advanced but not expended by September 30, 2006, within 31 days.
4. A final financial compilation report accounting for all funds expended will be provided to PPC no later than September 30, 2006.
5. It is agreed that PPC is responsible for its own actions or failure to act. The School Board recognizes its respective liability for certain tortious acts of its agents, officers, employees and invitees to the extent and limits provided in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, the State of Florida's partial waiver of Sovereign Immunity; provided, however, that this provision shall not be construed as a waiver of any right or defense that the School District has under statute.

Prevention Partnerships for Children, Inc. and School Board of Palm Beach County agree to comply with the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement.


