*Teachers have six (6) years after they first become responsible for the Language Arts instruction of a Limited English Proficient student to complete the required training to be in compliance with the ESOL / META Agreement. The teacher is responsible for 3 semester hours or 60 in-service credit points within the first two years of having LEP students assigned, and 3 semester hours or 60 in-service credit points each subsequent year that the teacher continues to be responsible for the Language Arts instruction of a LEP student, until a total of 15 semester hours or 300 in-service credit points have been earned. The teachers all hold valid subject area Educator Certificates, the majority teaching in-field of subject certification.
