The District Waiver Committee met to discuss the waiver request from Bak Middle School of the Arts. Bak requested a waiver from the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the SDPBC and the CTA through School Board Policy 3.01, Policy for Bargaining Unit Employees.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve the waiver request for one year, FY2006. The Waiver request will now be forwarded by Mr. Ludy to the CTA's Board for approval. Upon approval, Mr. Ludy will prepare a Memorandum of Understanding for the next School Board Meeting, where it will be voted on by the School Board.

The Committee discussed whether future District Waiver Committee meetings could be held by conference call. Bruce Harris will investigate this issue and report his findings to the Department of School Improvement.
