#### **GENERAL OBJECTIVE:**

To enable participants to demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to investigate the various components of a school's instructional program through the development of a SACS Guided Self-Study and to host a successful QAR visit.

- 7. Devise appropriate techniques for quality assurance for the school's improvement plan. (Guided Self-Study Section #4) (6)
- 8. Demonstrate an understanding of and identify links between the Guided Self-Study and the School Improvement Plan. (6)
- 9. Demonstrate an understanding of how to complete a Guided Self-Study. (6)
- 10. Demonstrate an understanding of how to train school personnel in preparation for the QAR visit. (6)

## **PROCEDURES:**

Participants will:

- 1. Attend training sessions to become familiar with all aspects of a SACS Guided Self-Study and QAR visit.
- 2. Organize the school into teams to analyze the school's instructional program.
- 3. Analyze all aspects of the school's instructional program.
- 4. Develop a Guided Self-Study document that reports the current state of the school's instructional program.
- 5. Organize and prepare their school for a QAR visit.

# **EVALUATION:**

Participants will:

- 1. Satisfactorily complete a Guided Self-Study document.
- 2. Receive a rating of "Continued Accreditation" from the QAR team as evidenced by a SACS QAR report.

# **FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES:**

Participants will:

- 1. Complete the Guided Self-Study (Obj. #1 8).
- 2. Complete a QAR visit (Obj. # 9, 10)
