GENERAL OBJECTIVE: To develop an understanding of how the implementation of the High/Scope Educational Approach for Infants and Toddlers can enhance the growth and development of our youngest learners.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE:

Upon completion of the training/workshop, the participant will:

- 1. identify the Key Experiences for infants and toddlers
- 2. develop an understanding of the Key Experiences in relation to active learning
- 3. analyze the Language and Literacy Key Experiences in relation to beginning reading
- 4. describe how the Key Experiences support sensory-motor development
- 5. demonstrate knowledge of ways to ensure that programs can be both predictable and flexible
- 6. describe ways the active, sensory-motor nature of infants and toddlers affect the way they use space and materials
- 7. describe effective strategies on the implementation of building order and flexibility into the physical environment
- 8. demonstrate an understanding of the importance of the outdoor play yard for infants and toddlers
- 9. facilitate communication on the importance of trusting relationships/attachment to infants and toddlers
- 10. define the role of primary caregivers to support children's trust and attachment needs
- 11. define how small group size support children's trust and attachment needs
- 12. define how continuity of care support children's trust and attachment needs
- 13. analyze the steps caregivers take to support toddlers when toddlers come in conflict with others
- 14. demonstrate an understanding of active learning for infants and toddlers
- 15. cite indicators on what active, sensory-motor infants and toddlers learn
- 16. demonstrate an understanding on the kinds of materials that are particularly appealing to infants and toddlers
- 17. demonstrate an understanding of the assessment of infants and toddlers active learning
- 18. create an understanding on the importance and benefits of positive caregiver/parent relationships
- 19. facilitate communication on the High Scope Infant Toddler Wheel of Learning
- 20. demonstrate an understanding of the importance of anecdotal record taking for infants and toddlers

DELIVERY PROCEDURES:

Participants will:

- 1. participate in all required training and/or workshops.
- 2. participate in discussion, role playing and problem solving strategies
- 3. read professional material related to the field of early childhood education.
- 4. network with participants to share best practices for infants and toddlers

EVALUATION OF PARTICIPANTS:

Participants will demonstrate mastery of the targeted objectives as evidenced through class presentations, product samples, reflections and homework assignments.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES:

Participants will provide documentation that shows:

- 3. written and oral reflections of course work.
- 4. shared ideas, research lessons and best practices as related to the High/Scope Educational Approach.
