

THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA BOARD AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

Approval of New Performance-Based Salary Schedule for Miscellaneous Employees

I recommend the School Board approve the new performance-based salary schedule for miscellaneous employees as submitted.

Discussions with the PBC Staff Association resulted in the following:

- Miscellaneous salary schedule will be increased 2%.
- Employees will be awarded a one (1) step increase.
- ➤ Food Service employees will receive an additional step based on market analysis.
- ➤ District administrators and representatives from the Staff Association will develop criteria and measures for performance salary incentives during the 2006-2007 school year. Performance incentives are anticipated to be funded in FY2008
- ➤ 2006 salary implementation will have an effective date of January 1, 2006.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial impact to the School District Operating Budget for FY06 is \$380,000. Additionally, the financial impact to the School Food Service Budget for FY06 is \$270,000.
