

RESOLUTION

The School Board of Palm Beach County Partnering With South Florida Science Museum Capital Campaign

WHEREAS, the South Florida Science Museum has provided affordable science educational programming to students and families in Palm Beach County for 45 years; and

WHEREAS, the Science Museum has worked with the School District of Palm Beach County to host field trips and create and deliver student science programs which meet Florida Sunshine State Standards and enhance School District science curriculum for all socio-economic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the population in Palm Beach County has grown from 120,000 to more than 1,200,000 since the Science Museum opened; and

WHEREAS, the Science Museum must grow to provide further education to the expanded population; and

WHEREAS, the Science Museum has undertaken a \$54 million Capital Campaign to build a state-of-the-art new science center to meet the needs of students and the community for science education;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Superintendent and the School Board of Palm Beach County School District do hereby declare its partnership with the South Florida Science Museum and supports its Capital Campaign and new state of the art facility.
