
Re: Request for two 77-passenger school buses

Dear Mr. Reed:

This coming school year, 2006-2007, we are adding two new bus routes, one of which is to the Western communities. By our enrollment estimates we will have about 68 to 74 students riding on the new Western communities route. A 77-passenger bus will service this route. Having only 65-passenger buses will force us to duplicate the route with two buses instead of one. Obviously, this will double our expenses paying for two bus drivers, insurance, gas and maintenance.

We are requesting two 77-passenger buses for this coming school year. We have hired two new bus drivers. We need the two 77-passenger buses because should one of the buses break down, we will have another we can use on that route. If we have only one 77-passenger bus, if it breaks down, we will not have two buses available to make that run.

Therefore, please consider our request for two 77-passenger school buses. Thank you.
