GENERAL OBJECTIVE: Participants will connect key concepts and standards taught in the Different Like Me[©] Curriculum to create a learning environment that fosters individual/group emotional management skills, promotes the development of empathy and positive peer relationships, and enhances classroom climate.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

Within the duration of the component, participants will:

- 1. Examine and understand the philosophical and educational components of the Different Like Me© Program.
- 2. Demonstrate an understanding of the role teacher attitudes, beliefs, practices and personal issues have on student behavior and classroom climate.
- 3. Identify the direct and indirect forms of teasing and bullying behaviors.
- 4. Demonstrate an understanding of the needs of diverse learners and special needs students.
- 5. Demonstrate an understanding of methods that foster empathy in students.
- 6. Demonstrate an understanding of techniques that emphasize mutual respect as applied to ESE populations.
- 7. Demonstrate an understanding of methods of expanding interpersonal skills through classroom demonstrations, activities and role-plays.

PROCEDURES:

The participants will:

- 1. Attend a 3 hour seminar focusing on the Different Like Me© Curriculum.
- 2. Engage in instruction that utilizes hands-on self-actualization activities designed to encourage the participants to examine their personal style of teaching and how it impacts their students.
- 3. Engage in small and large group interactive activities that focus on identifying and discussing the impact special needs students (identified or unidentified) have on themselves, the students and classroom climate.
- 4. Deliver instruction that articulates the impact that teasing and bullying has on students.
- 5. Implement the Different Like Me© Curriculum.
- 6. Analyze and discuss the Different Like Me[®] Pre and Post required documents.

EVALUATION OF PARTICIPANTS:

- 1. Participant's will complete the Different Like Me[©] Pre and Post required documents to determine factual knowledge and skill acquisition.
- 2. Participants will demonstrate their newly acquired skills through small group activities, discussions and implementation action plan.

FOLLOW-UP:

The participants will:

- 1. Conduct a series of 8-12 Different Like Me[®] Lessons.
- 2. Provide activities for their students to practice the skills they have acquired to better prepare them for "real-life" situations.
- 3. Complete assessments to evaluate student(s) performance, interactions, and overall classroom climate.
- 4. Complete questionnaires that invite participants to analyze and reflect their own performance and to design changes needed to maximize their own personal and professional development.

COMPONENT EVALUATION:

Participants and professional developer will assess the degree to which the component goals were met and make recommendations for revisions through the component evaluation.
