Definitions of Rated Areas

- 6. <u>Technical Competence</u>. The Firm studies and understands the technical requirements of the contract documents, specifically, the plans and specifications. The Firm exhibits the experience and resources necessary to accomplish project requirements.
- Safety. The Firm complies with OSHA requirements and is attentive to safety during all construction activities. The Firm performs safety inspections and conducts regular safety training sessions with all workers.
- Schedule. The Firm prepares a complete project schedule that fulfills the contract requirements, prosecutes the work as to maintain the project schedule and provides monthly schedule updates that reflect the progress of the work.
- 9. <u>Submittals, RFIs, RFPs, Documentation and Close Out</u>. The Firm submits all project related contract documentation in a timely manner. Documentation is complete and technically accurate, provides the information necessary to address issues, and accomplishes contract requirements.
- Environmental Compliance. The Firm is aware of the sensitivity of the environment and takes necessary precautions. The Firm complies with all conditions of environmental permits and appropriate laws and regulations.
