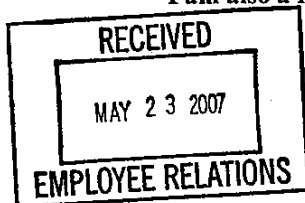
Notice of appeal a decision made
