Teacher Evaluations:

JA BizTown™ Overview

JA BizTown is the new name for JA Worldwide's experiential-based, elementary school capstone program. In addition to the new name, *JA BizTown* has undergone substantial revisions to the curriculum, simulation, and software elements of the program.

Overview

JA BizTown encompasses important elements of work readiness, entrepreneurship, and financial literacy, providing students in grades four through six with a solid foundation of business, economics, and free enterprise education. Furthermore, the program content augments students' core curriculum in social studies (e.g., citizenship, government), reading, writing, and mathematics. Throughout the program, students are encouraged to use critical thinking skills to learn about key economic concepts as they explore and enhance their understanding of free enterprise.

Through daily lessons, hands-on activities, and active participation in a simulated community designed to support differentiated learning styles, students develop a strong understanding of the relationship between what they learn in school and their successful participation in a local economy. *JA BizTown* helps prepare students for a lifetime of learning and academic achievement.

JA BizTown Goals

JA BizTown meets the needs of a diverse group of students by providing engaging, academically enriching, experiential lessons.

Following participation in the JA BizTown experience, students will be able to:

- Discuss the roles they, as citizens, play in their community as workers and consumers and relate these
- · personal roles to the free enterprise system.
- Discuss the importance of citizen rights and responsibilities in a community.
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of the free enterprise system.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the importance of nonprofit organizations in our communities.
- Build money management skills through a practical knowledge of economic concepts and banking practices.
- Develop an understanding of basic business practices and responsibilities.
- Demonstrate the soft skills necessary for their successful participation in the world of work.

Curriculum

The *JA BizTown* curriculum is designed to minimize lesson preparation time through an efficient lesson organization. The lessons are designed as a framework and can be adapted to meet the special needs and interests of students in the classroom. However, students should complete each required lesson to ensure that they have the background knowledge necessary to fully participate in the *JA BizTown* experience. In addition, Enhanced Learning Opportunities, which will allow teachers to provide optional activities that complement the core curriculum, will be available. Teachers can choose, at their discretion, to have students participate in some, all, or none of these activities.

Following their participation in the *JA BizTown* simulation, students participate in debriefing lessons to ensure a well rounded learning experience. These lessons allow students to reflect on their *JA BizTown* experience and further identify the relevance of classroom learning to their future plans and goals.

In an effort to address multiple learning styles, various teaching strategies are included throughout the curriculum to actively engage students in the learning process. Please refer to the *JA BizTown* Curriculum Overview for a summary of the key concepts included in each lesson of the program.

ISSUES RELATING TO PARTICIPATION:

- A. For 2000-2003, the PBC School District specified which schools would participate
- B. From 2003-2007, all principals were invited to select a participation date, and dates were issued on a first come, first served basis.
- C. Starting in 2003, available days of participation were decreased due to increased days set aside for FCAT Blackout Period by the School District. Also, 21 schools were given exemptions from participation.
- D. In 2004, the PBC Transportation Dept requested that JA not schedule PBC schools on LTM days which decreased the number of available days
- E. In 2005, the PBC School District requested that all AAA schools be granted a waiver from participation if they couldn't obtain a visit date after the FCAT test period.
- F. In 2004-05 and 2005-06, hurricanes decreased available days and school participation
- G. In 2006-07, 9 schools cancelled their confirmed dates because poor diagnostic test results created a need to focus exclusively on AYP goals, while 6 schools cancelled for other reasons. The late notice of the cancellations precluded scheduling another school in their place resulting in a total loss of 19 available days of participation and a total loss of 1,782 students.
