SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AND DELRAY YOUTH VOCATIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL.

This Amendment dated the __ day of _____, 2007 to the Charter Agreement between The School Board of Palm Beach County, Florida ("Sponsor"), and Delray Youth Vocational Charter School dated June 26, 2002 is entered into by the parties through their undersigned authorities. The parties hereby stipulate and agree that to the extent any conflict exists between any of the terms or conditions of the original Charter Agreement or any attachment and exhibits thereto, and any other preexisting amendment thereto this Amendment shall govern.

In consideration of the mutual covenants embodied herein and other valuable consideration, the Sponsor and Delray Youth Vocational Charter School hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The existing contract between the parties is for a five (5) year term beginning July 1, 2002 and terminating June 30, 2007.
- 2. Delray Youth has timely expressed its intent to seek renewal of the 2004 Charter Agreement for an additional 5 years beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2012.
- 3. In order to complete meaningful negotiations to secure a mutually beneficial and legally binding Charter Agreement, the parties agree that it is necessary for their mutual benefit and protection that the term of existence of the Charter Agreement dated June 26, 2002 must be extended.
- 4. Wherefore the parties agree that the term for existence of the Charter agreement dated June 26, 2002 shall be hereby extended 45 days from the extended date of August 14, 2007 to September 28, 2007.
- 5. All other terms of the charter shall remain in full force and effect subject to further extension of time as mutually deemed necessary by the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereby execute this Amendment to the Charter Agreement which is effective on the date last executed by all Parties.
